"Dawn of GAIA" (TV Tokyo)

This is a series of economics and business documentaries that has been broadcast since 2002. Aiming to bring across the message that "the dawn is breaking, and Japan's economy is being revitalized," these documentaries showcase people who are playing a leading role in a variety of economic and business fields.



"Cambrian Palace" (TV Tokyo)

Launched in 2006, "Cambrian Palace" is a talk show in which famous author Ryu Murakami chats with guests who include entrepreneurs and business executives who are currently in the news. These programs feature businesspeople talking with passion about their business activities.



"Future Century Zipangu" (TV Tokyo)

First broadcast in 2011, this economic and business television series introduces countries that have close relations with Japan of which Japanese people are generally unaware, as well as other countries that are becoming increasingly important in today's world, and seeks to forecast how the relationship between these countries and Japan will develop in the future.



"Big Boys Club" (Discovery Channel)

This program showcases the many types of high-performing heavy industrial machinery that Japan has developed, honed by the country's limited land area and rough terrain, and sheds light on the secrets behind their amazing performance.



"Kirin Art Gallery" (TV Tokyo)

Each episode of this art education series showcases a single painting (or other work of art), including both Japanese and foreign works, outlining the dramatic stories and mysteries associated with each work, and exploring the lives of the outstanding artists who created these beautiful masterpieces.
